This policy applies to all centers included in the Child and Adult Care Food Program Agreement unless otherwise noted.

Family income information will be maintained on all children and adults whose meals will be reported as free or reduced price and the sponsor assures New Mexico Children, Youth and Families Department that all participants will meet the prescribed eligibility criteria. The Family Income Eligibility Guidelines prescribed by the Secretary of Agriculture will be used to make this determination.
