# **Goals of our Partnership**

To study and support the new FOCUS TQRIS:

#### Activity 1: Study the new FOCUS rating criteria and process

- Review FOCUS ratings process
- Pilot revised criteria and ratings process
- Validate FOCUS with programs and children

#### **Activity 2: Develop a new Continuous Program Improvement process**

- Draft tools, resources and gather feedback
- Pilot and refine
- Finalize for program use



# Activity 1: Study the new FOCUS rating criteria and process













### Step 1: Review FOCUS Rating Criteria and Process

- Review rating documents from 50 newly rated programs
- Conduct interviews with FOCUS staff
- Provide recommendations for strengthening rating, monitoring, and verification processes
- Develop documentation to support training and reliability for raters



• FOCUS administrative data will be provided to Child Trends for review of the rating process.





# Step 2: Pilot revised criteria and ratings process









# We may be asking for your feedback on your experiences in the FOCUS TQRIS, which may include:

- Phone interviews
- Online surveys





# Step 3: Validate FOCUS with Programs and Children

- Use ERS, CLASS and other measures of quality to validate the levels of quality in FOCUS
  - For example, to what extent do these rating tools distinguish meaningful levels of quality?
- Collect information about children's development to identify any connections with FOCUS quality levels
  - Children attending rated programs will be assessed in the fall and spring of 2014-2015



- We may ask to come to your program to conduct on-site observations.
- We may come to your program to assess children on early language/literacy and math skills.
- We may ask you to fill out information on children's social/emotional development.



### Activity 2: Development of Continuous Program Improvement process







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#### What steps are involved?

- Develop a tool to support programs in continuous quality improvement
  - Tool will assess concepts that are relevant to programs and that are linked to child outcomes
- The first draft will be developed early 2013
- Final draft mid-2013 followed by an implementation and monitoring plan



- We may ask you to use the CPI tool and ask for your feedback.
  - The tool will involve assessing your programs strengths and weaknesses
  - Working with materials/activities designed to help you improve program quality
  - Your FOCUS consultant will work with you closely as you learn to use the tool
