The Early Learning Series (ELS):

This training series explores the NM Early Learning Guidelines (ELG) and the NM Authentic Observation Documentation and Curriculum Planning (AODCP) process including portfolio collection, authentic assessment, lesson planning, and community collaboration. This training series is:

Health and Safety Orientation:

This training includes topics such as the prevention of infectious disease; emergency preparedness; safe sleep practices; and prevention and reporting of child abuse. (**Disponible en español available in Spanish**) (NM Competencies: 2 (3hr)) **Powerful Interactions:**

The book Powerful Interactions, written by A. Dombro, J. Jablon, & C. Stetson, provides the foundation for this 4-hour training about practical and influential ways to interact with young children. Join us as we explore a number of practical insights and strategies that can help to increase our effectiveness as educators of young children. Quality Early Childhood Programs for All:

This course is designed as an introduction to special services and inclusion resources available to support early childhood professionals so that every child is included in early childhood programs. Ideas for building family partnerships and information about service providers will be highlighted. A review of related laws is also included in the course. All child care educators working in 3-STAR and 4-STAR licensed child care centers and family child care homes are required to complete this course, or its equivalent, within the first six months of employment. (NM Competencies: 3 (2hr), 4 (1hr), 5 (1hr), 7 (2hr))
