## Become a Registered Home Child Care Provider

#### Step 1-Background Check Process.

Follow the instructions and complete the forms in the background check and fingerprint packet. The provider and all household members over 18 must have a background check if receiving child care subsidy.

#### Step 2-Application Process.

Once you receive the background check approval letter(s), submit the following completed documents to your local Child Care Specialist to become a registered provider:

- 1. Provider Participation
  - Agreement/Registered Home Application
- 2. Copy of your approved background check letter
- 3. Copy of your Photo ID and Social Security card, if applicable.

#### Step 3-Preparing for your home visit.

The following must be present in the home to receive certification:

- Smoke alarm
- Carbon Monoxide detector
- Fire extinguisher
- Thermometers for refrigerator

- First Aid kit
- Current immunization records for the children in your care
- If pets are in the home- current vaccinations for them
- Safe outdoor play space

#### Step 4-Contact Child Care Food Program.

Once you have received your approved Registration form, you will need to contact the Child Care Food Program in your area, (Note: list provided in the registration packet.)
