### Free COVID-19 Testing for Early Childhood Professionals

All licensed facility and registered home provider staff that <u>live or work</u> in a county <u>displayed in red, orange or yellow</u>, are **required** to get tested for COVID-19, **every other week**. These geographical distinctions are based on a fourteen-day rolling average of new daily cases and overall positivity rate
